THE SCHOOL

The International Leadership of Texas Keller-Saginaw High School is a charter school that opened in August 2015 with an emphasis on language, service, and leadership to ensure that future generations are prepared for today’s internationally connected world.

Education is taught from a global perspective. Every student enrolls in English, Spanish, and Mandarin Chinese classes and are tasked with the goal of being trilingual by graduation. Our motto “Others before self” is at the heart of everything we do. Leadership and service are incorporated into our curriculum through mandatory leadership courses and class service projects. All students are expected to complete at least 60 hours of community service by graduation.

Students take 10 courses per year on a block schedule. Each year, every student enrolls in 4 core academic courses, 2 foreign languages (Mandarin Chinese and Spanish are required), a leadership course, and athletic conditioning, which allows for students to choose 2 elective courses. Dual-credit is offered in conjunction with Tarrant Community College and may be the most rigorous course available in some cases.

COLLEGE PREP | VISITS

International Leadership of Texas has partnered with the Academic Success Program to provide individual, comprehensive college counseling services to all students. ASP is using SCOIR to schedule college visits and send application materials electronically. College visits will generally be intimate, small group settings in our office or another appropriate space. CLASS RANK | GPA | GRADING SCALE

GPA is cumulative and calculated on both a 100-point and four-point scale. The GPA calculated on a four-point scale is unweighted and includes all high school and dual-credit college classes, regardless of where classes were taken. **The local GPA is calculated on a 100-point scale and includes only the high school and dual-credit college classes a student has taken while enrolled in an ILTexas school.** The weightings are based on the following scale: Advanced Placement/Dual Credit—1.15, Honors/Pre-AP—1.1, All other courses—1. Scores earned via credit by examination or examinations taken for acceleration are not included in the GPA. Outside of the top 10% of the class, the International Leadership of Texas does not rank.

The equivalent scale for numerical grades on a 100 and 4.0 grade point system is as follows:

A = 90 – 100 | 4.0

B = 80 – 89 | 3.0

C = 70 – 79 | 2.0

F = Below 70 | 0.0
